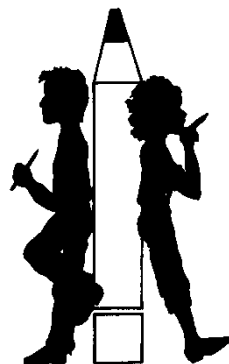


Green Bay Area Public School District 2017 Summer School Offerings Grades K – 12

The following information applies to the District Summer School Program as specified in this coursebook, and does not include information on individual summer school programs being held at school sites. Please contact your school for information on their summer programs.

Who is eligible to register?

1. Students who currently attend one of the Green Bay Area Public Schools listed on Page 2.
2. Private school students who live within Green Bay School District Boundaries may attend Green Bay Summer School program, and are required to complete and submit the 2017 Summer School Enrollment Form in addition to all other necessary registration forms.
3. Students who do not live within the Green Bay School District boundaries and are not currently enrolled in a Green Bay School may be eligible to enroll and register for Green Bay Summer School, with a \$50.00 fee per course.

What are the dates for registration?

1. Applications must be submitted within the open registration window from **April 3-17, 2017**. The district retains the right to cancel courses if enrollment is too low, and implement a lottery if enrollment exceeds capacity.

What is the registration process?

1. **OPTION 1:** Students who have already activated their student portal and have their login information can register online from **April 3-17, 2017**. Please refer to the Portal Course Registration Instructions in this booklet. If you are requesting busing to Beaumont or Sullivan, please send your transportation request form to: Green Bay Area Public Schools, ATTN: Summer School, 200 South Broadway, Green Bay, Wisconsin 54303.
2. **OPTION 2:** Students without student portal access should complete the Course Registration and Transportation Request forms, and drop them off or mail them to: Green Bay Area Public Schools, ATTN: Summer School, 200 South Broadway, Green Bay, Wisconsin 54303 **no later than April 17, 2017**.
3. All students who are **not currently enrolled** in Green Bay Schools and are requesting enrollment in GBAPS Summer School must complete the 2017 Summer School Enrollment Form in addition to all other registration forms.
4. Students who do **not live within the Green Bay district boundaries** and are **not currently enrolled in a Green Bay school** must submit the **\$50.00** fee along with the 2017 Summer School Enrollment Form in addition to all other registration forms.

Is transportation available?

1. Transportation is available for students who register for the KG-6 Math, Reading, and Enrichment courses held at **Beaumont and Sullivan** Schools. Please see page 23-24 of this coursebook for instructions and sign-up forms. Busing will be available for students who include their transportation request along with their course registration within the open registration window. Busing may not be available for late requests, so please include your transportation request with your course registration sheet from April 3-17, 2017

The following programs outlined below are included in detail in this coursebook. All courses included in this coursebook are available for registration through the student portal April 3-17, 2017.

Grades KG - 6 Math, Reading, and Enrichment Courses (Pages 6-15)

On the Road to Math and On the Road to Reading (Pages 6-8) courses are designed to provide extended learning opportunities to strengthen or enhance skills in these essential core content areas. These courses are open to all students entering grades KG-6, although priority will be given to students who have been invited to participate, or those students whose school does not offer a Math or Reading summer school program. Please see the coursebook descriptions for details on course offerings, dates, times, and locations.

Enrichment (pages 9–15) courses are designed to provide extended learning opportunities to strengthen or enhance skills in all content areas. These courses are open to students in the specified grade levels, although Math and Reading courses will take priority over enrichment courses for those students who have been encouraged to participate in Math and Reading. Please see coursebook descriptions for details on course offerings, dates, times, and locations.

Participants will have the opportunity to take up to two classes per session for a total of up to four classes. Classes will run Monday – Friday, and lunch will be served, free of charge, from 12:00 to 12:30 pm on site at each school.

All KG-6 Math, Reading, and Enrichment classes will be held at Sullivan and Beaumont Elementary Schools and follow the schedule below. Please see the coursebook for course descriptions, dates, times, and locations.

Online High School Credit-Earning Courses: (Pages 16-17)

Online High School Credit courses are designed for students entering grades 9-12 as specified in the course descriptions. *Please refer to the special instructions for requirements and approval to take online courses.*

Each middle and high school will be offering individualized summer school programs tailored to the needs of their students. Please contact your middle or high school for specific information on their course offerings, dates, times, and registration process.

Some of the courses offered by middle and high school summer programs are listed below:

- **Middle School Matters - 6th Grade Orientation:** Middle School Matters is an orientation program for all incoming 6th grade students and is held at each Middle School in the Green Bay Area Public School District. Please contact the middle school your student will be attending for details on dates, times, and registration process for Middle School Matters.
- **Freshman Forward – 9th Grade Orientation:** Freshman Forward is an orientation program for all incoming 9th grade students and is held at each High School in the Green Bay Area Public School District. Please contact the high school your student will be attending for details on dates, times, and registration process for Freshman Forward.
- **Grades 9-12 Credit-Earning Courses:** High School Credit courses are designed for students entering grades 9-12 who are taking a course for the first-time. These are full-semester content courses, and attendance is required in order to obtain the full credit for these courses. Space in these courses is limited, so priority will be given to those students who are behind in credits, and on a descending grade level basis. If necessary, a lottery may be implemented after priorities are met, to ensure non-preferential placement of the remaining registration requests. These courses are not included in this coursebook, and will vary by school. Please contact your high school counselor for details on courses, dates and times of new credit courses offered at your high school.
- **Grades 9-12 Credit Recovery Courses:** Continuous Progress and Credit Recovery courses will be offered at each high school based on student needs. These courses are not included in this coursebook, and will vary by school. Please contact your high school counselor for details on courses, dates, and times of credit recovery and make-up credit courses offered at your high school.

PLEASE NOTE: Course expectations for credit courses mirror those of the regular year, including assignments and final exams. State and local standards/benchmarks are covered. All school rules for attendance and behavior are enforced. Disruptive students may be removed from the class so the learning experience can remain positive for other class members.

ATTENDANCE: Due to the compressed schedule, students are expected to attend every day. Family vacations, trips, and camps are not excused absences. Summer school is not the best option if such plans are already in place.

If you request busing, please sign up for classes offered only at the location that is eligible for busing from your home school, and return the completed Transportation Form to: Green Bay Schools, ATTN: Summer School, 200 S. Broadway, Green Bay, WI 54303.
- **Grades 9-12 Online High School Credit:** You may register for one online class, provided you meet the eligibility requirements for the online class you register for. Please talk to your school counselor to determine your eligibility prior to registering for online courses.
- If you register for your summer school courses through the portal, you do **not** need to complete and return the Course Registration Sheet.
- If you are requesting **busing** to Sullivan or Beaumont as part of this portal course registration, you will need to complete and return the Transportation Form.
