

Posting of Academic Standards Used in the Green Bay Area Public School District, 2023-2024

School Boards are required by section 120.12(13) of the state statutes to notify the parent/guardians of students enrolled in the school district of the student academic standards that will be in effect for the school year prior to the beginning of each school term. This notice may be provided electronically, including by posting the notice or a link to the specific academic standards on the school district's website. Also, the school board must annually include an item on the agenda of the first school board meeting of the school year (the first board meeting after July 1) that clearly identifies the student academic standards adopted by the board under section 118.30(1g)(a)1 of the state statutes that will be in effect for the school year.
