# **Intra-District Transfer**

Parents may choose to send their student to a Green Bay Area Public School other than the one in his or her attendance area. Applications are usually accepted from the beginning of January through the end of April. There is a preference window, typically January, when intra-district transfer applications are considered prior to open enrollment applications. More information and application windows can be found at abaps.org/intradistrict transfer.

# **Open Enrollment**

The open enrollment program allows parents to apply for their children to attend a public school in a school district other than the one in which they reside. Any Wisconsin resident 4K to grade 12 may apply to attend a nonresident school district under the open enrollment program. The open enrollment application period usually runs from the beginning of February until the end of April. Learn more at dpi.wi.gov/open-enrollment.

- Special education services are offered in every District school; however, to best serve students with more significant needs, the District also has specialty focus programs. Focus programs may change location due to student need and space availability.
- All students have access to the Board adopted universal curriculum and resources. Bilingual students learn the universal curriculum in both Spanish and English.
